## **ABOUT ADVANCED TEAM TRAINING:**

Advanced Team Trainings are exclusively for Team Training alumni. These 2-day in-person programs are presented each year and provide a deep focus on a specific topic looking through the lens of the different disciplines of the team to address the challenges of the specific topic. Topics are selected each year through surveying the attendees about topics they are most challenged with in caring for people living with Parkinson's.

New Insights in Clinical Management of Newly Diagnosed, Early Parkinson's and Young-Onset Parkinson's disease

1. Apply proactive rehabilitation strategies tailored to the distinct needs of individuals with newly diagnosed Parkinson's, early Parkinson's disease, and/or Young-Onset Parkinson's disease (YOPD).
2. Address the psychosocial challenges and life-stage-specific needs of Parkinson's patients through an interprofessional approach.
3. Integrate updates on clinical research, emerging therapeutics, and genetic insight into the management of newly diagnosed Parkinson's, early Parkinson's disease, and/or YOPD to improve patient outcomes.

## ELIGIBILITY:

Team Training Alumni (those who have completed a past Team Training course), or those who have completed their registration to attend the 2025 Team Training course in Denver are eligible to register for the Advanced Team Training.

## REGISTRATION PRICES:

- **Early registration is May 1-July 11:** \$500 registration fee
- **Regular registration July 12-September 30:** \$550 registration fee.  
This program is offered to a mix of professions and when the maximum capacity of one or more discipline tracks is reached or approaching max capacity, a message will be on the program pages in the Learning Lab. - **VA discount:** \$357.50 per person up to 15 VA discounts

- **Be prepared to pay immediately following program registration.** Registration is completed once electronic payment has been made. Registrations without payment within 24 hours will be cancelled.
